




Breast Health- Teaching & Training

- MCh curriculum
 - No. of journal club presentations relating breast (2000-2005): 54
 - No. of seminars relating breast (2000-2005): 28
 - Inter-dept meetings, tumor board, academic rounds
- Short term training opportunities
 - Some 7 requests from surgeons from various Asian and African countries, and similar numbers from Indian surgeons recd for short term training in breast surgery during the last 5 years.



Breast Health- CME's SGPGI Breast Courses

- Planned as biennial programs
- First SGPGI Breast Course- March 2005
 - 4 Intl, 22 Natl faculty; 136 delegates
- Second SGPGI Breast Course- Nov 2006
 - 5 international and 18 national faculty; 120 delegates



Breast Health- Research

- Research projects: (2000-2005)
 - Extramural- 2 (ongoing)
 - Intramural- 5 (completed), 2 (ongoing)
 - Inter-institutional collaborative- 3 (with CDRI, ITRC, KGMU)
 - Participation in multi-center trials- 3
- Publications: 3 full length, 4 case reports, 4 abstracts
- Presentations: 6 invited lectures (3 intl), 8 free papers/ posters
 - 2 best paper (one intl), one best poster (intl.) awards



Breast Health- Community Activities

- Breast health awareness lectures (2000-2005): 33
 - Including 3 at Kanpur, 1 at Almora, many more in neighboring towns/ cities
 - No. of women reached- approx 3000
- Free Breast cancer screening camps: 7 (two at SGPGI)
 - No. of women screened- approx 400
